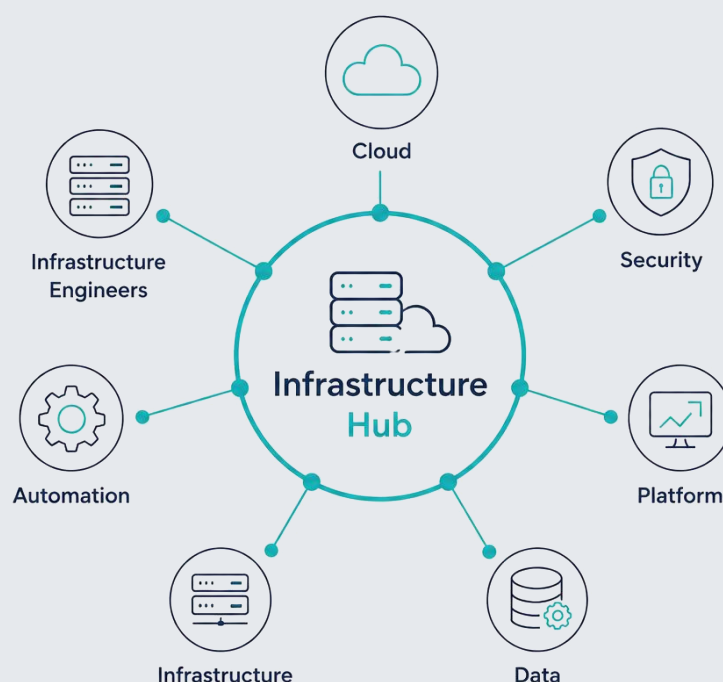
The model is based on four guiding principles.

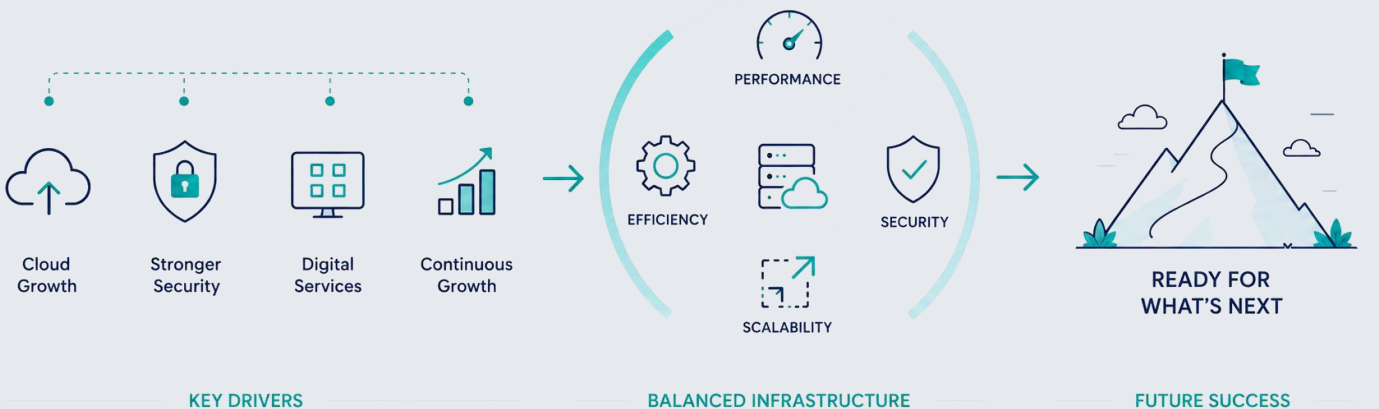
## ➤ The Future of Infrastructure Operations
